Targeted support:

Yr. 6 Booster groups supporting pupils to achieve L3/4 and L4/5 and revision guides

Full time TA support at KS2

1:1 support including a designated 1:1 teacher

School uniform and sports kit

Extended school support:

Fees for after school clubs such as multi-sports

Extra curricular music lessons such as piano tuition

Individual support for residential trips, subsidy for day trips

Study support

School website for sharing information and activities

Pupil Premium Impact:

PP does not completely pay for all the support listed above but with subsidy from the main school budget, it ensures continuation of a good level and mixture of support.

All the PP children who were/are KS2 pupils, benefited from the additional full time TA support not just with their learning but also by providing valuable emotional support which helped to keep pupils on task. [See SATs and tracking results](#)
