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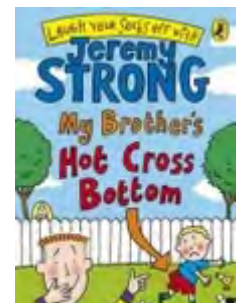
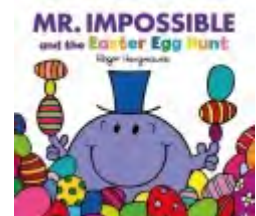

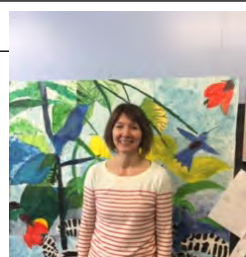
When all the reception children were independent enough to come into school on their own.

I would also like to remind you the car park at the school is for staff only.

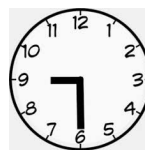
