





Reds were the loudest.





Yellows were the brightest,




and Blues were the coolest.










The colors decided

And something happened.




Yellow and Blue became inseparable.




Life felt so vibrant!

Green was bright like Yellow







There were so many new colors. And a lot of new names.


Step 1:

Draw a circle for the body.




Step 2:

Draw a line and a circle for the legs and feet.




Step 3:

Draw lines for the arms and the fingers. Use a circle for the finger tips!





Draw the eyes and nose using circles and dots.


