# **English**



We have used laptops to find out facts about what harvest means to us and to farmers. We discussed things we have experience of harvesting, e.g. apples and blackberries. We were interested to learn the range of equipment farmers use to harvest on a large scale.

We found out about the history of harvest and why it is an important celebration for Christians.

Some children have been learning to spell the 'c' sound as 'k' before i, y and e. Some children have been learning spelling rules for homophones.

We have learned how to add two and three digits using the column addition method. Our top tip is to start with the ones before looking at the other columns. Some of us have been using our knowledge of doubles and bonds to add mentally. A few of us have solved addition word problems.

We have learned how our knowledge of multiplication facts helps us with division.

We have reviewed all our times tables covered this term and we have been impressed with how quickly the children are starting to recall these facts.

## **Topic**

As palaeontologists we have looked at the tools that we would need to uncover fossils.

As artists we have made fossils by imprinting objects into clay to make trace and body fossils.

As technicians, we have used laptops to find out information about dinosaurs on the Natural History Museum website. We have also taken turns to use our school VR (virtual reality) headsets. We felt like we were walking with real dinosaurs!


#### <u>Harvest Festival</u>
