#### **English**

This week we have been looking at a picture of the day and discussing what we can see, what we think and what we wonder from the picture. We have reminded ourselves about the different ways to punctuate sentences and been punctuation detectives. We have recapped about when to use capital letters. We have also recapped our understanding of nouns, verbs and adverbs.

We have read the bible story of the Lost Sheep and rehearsed sentences to write the story in our own words.

#### Maths

We have been using our knowledge of times tables facts to solve written word calculations and number puzzles.

Our new theme this week was learning about fractions. We have focused our learning this week on making equal and unequal parts. We have used this information to help us recognise and find half of an object, quantity or number.

Our steps: what is the whole? What are the parts? Are the parts equal? How do we know?
