This week we have shared our knowledge and understanding of harvest. We have found out about the populations of the different continents across the world and how food is distributed and where our food comes from.

We have listened to stories from children living on different continents across the world and compared their lives with our own.

Together we have drafted, edited and written an acrostic poem using the letters from Harvest.



This week we have continued revising our subtraction strategies by using column and counting on methods.

We have been looking at symmetry and 2D shapes thinking about properties to describe them. We have also found out how to measure the radius of a circle. Children in Year 3 have made symmetrical pictures and patterns with a partner. In Year 4, children have learnt how to use a pair of compasses to help them draw circles to set distances.
