

Gatekeepers class Week ending 21st January 2022 Core value focus: Trust



English & Art

This week we have taken part in a whole school federation and diocesan project called The colours of us. For inspiration to start the project we read the book The colours of us by Angelica Dass which celebrates the diverse beauty of human skin. We then completed our own self-portraits looking carefully at skin tone, eye colour, hair colour and other facial features. We were amazed to learn that even with our differences, humans are 99.9% biologically identical and skin, hair and eye colour is only found in the last 0.1%.



Maths

We have learned how to add money using compact and expanded methods.

We have also learned about the number system in ancient Maya and completed investigations to decode their numbers. We were surprised to learn their number system consisted of only 3 symbols which represented 0, 1 and 5.

Science

The children worked in groups to complete a challenge to build a standalone structure to hold a tennis ball using just 10 sheets of paper and 1m of sticky tape. The aim was to complete a structure at least as high as our tables. Following this, we looked back at a picture of a human skeleton and learned about what makes bones such as the legs, pelvis and backbone effective at support.
