English



This week we have been looking at a book called The Journey by Francesca Sanna. We have examined the images, made predictions and discussed how the pictures help tell the emotions and set the scene for the events in the story. We have learned the words: journey, chaos, migration, border and refugee. We debated the best fit genre for the story as it is fictional but based on real life accounts.

We have written a book review using examples to frame our ideas.

Geography



In Geography we have continued our learning about South America. This week our focus was on Lake Titicaca. The children were surprised to learn the Uros live on islands made of living reeds that float around the lake.

We also looked at the terms human and physical features.

Maths

This week we have been continuing with our focus on addition and subtraction techniques. We have reminded ourselves of the different synonyms for these operations. We have used rounding skills to mentally estimate answers before using expanded or compact methods to calculate them accurately, e.g.

436 + 549, mentally rounded to 440 + 550 = 990. We have used this method to help identify if answers to different calculations 'look about right' or there's been an error in exchanging or strategy used.



In DT the children have found out a bit more about the Mayan diet. They handled and tasted tortilla chips, sweetcorn and avocado.
