
Supporting reading comprehension at home



As your child grows into an **independent reader** you can teach them how to develop their comprehension skills by:

- 1. Talking together about what you are reading eg: What do you think is happening? What might happen next?
- 2. Summarising or identifying the key points of a story or information text
- 3. Drawing illustrations or creating a mind map about the book
- 4. Developing questioning strategies, eg: Did that make sense? Why do you think that happened?

Some good words to start your questions are: Why? Who? Which? When? and How?
